








NATIONAL MANDATES DEVELOPED ON THE BASIS OF MANDATES OF THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION

ACTION PLAN

- To develop and adopt State Construction Norms for sustainable use of natural resources
- To make a list of international and regional standards which are referenced in harmonized European standards and to adopt them by translating into Ukrainian as identical national standards
- To follow updates of harmonized European standards and EADs to discover modifications, technical corrigenda or amendments and adopt them as national standards.
- For each product area, make a list of EADs and to adopt them by translating into Ukrainian as identical national standards
- To list equipments needed for tests which are given in relevant harmonized European standards
